High School Confirmation Prep Program Guidelines

10th grade Confirmation Prep classes will be from **11:00AM-12:00PM**. Students can be dropped off no earlier than 10:45am. Students will have class beginning at 11am at the Parish Office/Youth Ministry building located on the other side of the Church parking lot. Students are encouraged to attend the 10am Mass, however they are welcome to attend any of the weekend Masses at IHM. Students will be required to sign in at the back of the Church for Mass every weekend.

Class will end at 12:00PM at which time parents may pick up those students who are not driving themselves.

Parents are asked to wait for their children outside of the Parish Office/Youth Ministry building.

Students are to attend all classes and are to report on time. If an absence is unavoidable, please call the Parish Office to report the absence.

If your child is absent, parents are to help teach the missing material by completing the textbook chapters at home as well as watching the missing video components. The missing material must be completed and shown to the catechist when your child returns to class.

Children who miss more than three classes during the year will repeat the entire year the following school year.

There is a \$20.00 charge to replace lost textbooks.

Parents are not to take children from class before dismissal time.

Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Any student acting in poor behavior will be asked to call his/her parents to come and pick him/her up. Parents will then need to arrange a meeting with the teacher, program manager, and the student before the student will be admitted back into the class.

Cell phones, ipods, electronic games and all other personal electronics are not permitted in classes. **These items must be powered off during class.**
